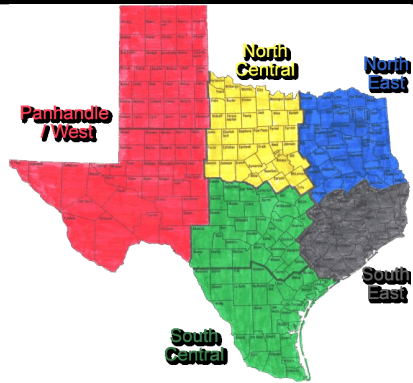

I'm thrilled you picked me and didn't leave me on the bench waiting for someone to pick me like when I was in grade school. But now oh dear, I have to write how Daisy Dot got started... then pick someone else to carry the torch... ok here the clown story of Daisy Dots beginning.

One evening scrolling through information on the internet, 7 years ago, I saw an ad for "Joey To The World". Wow Christian Clowning, now that sounded really interesting, I turned around to my husband and asked "What would you think if I wanted to become a Christian clown? Would you mind?" He said, "You can if you want to, but I don't know why you would want to". I asked, "Would you go with me?" My very shy hubby said, "ABSOLUTELY NOT!!!"

That was the answer I expected so I sat there for a few minutes pondering, how I could make this work, how exciting it would be for the kids if I could tell them bible stories and do balloons at the same time. Yes, the Lord gave me the courage to pick up the phone and call a lady in our church that I thought, she might just want to go with me. I asked Jane Wilson if she would like to go with me and before we could catch our breath, we were registered and we so excited. Planning all kinds of exciting



things, we were going do for our community if we could really learn all they advertised in 2 days.

A couple weeks later, we drove to Hurst Baptist church and got our goodie bags and met so many sweet and helpful people. There were so many classes, we learned the basics for makeup and character development and about going to Nursing Homes and Hospitals. We struggled through a class on throwing scarfs up and trying to catch them, yes, a juggling class, that if graded would have been a failure but we considered it a fun class in humor as we learned to laugh at our attempts. Even with one on one attention, I could not master throwing as I caught, but we did learn that even if you never master the art, you can play with it and make it part of an act. We bought supplies and costumes and just tried to get a little of everything we saw. Joey to the World now called Glow has a very special place in my heart, and I love attending and learning from so many wonderful people.

Coming home full of information and very little ability did not stop us as two weeks later, we had talked the preacher into letting us do a "Jesus Loves Me Valentine party" for the community of Chandler, Texas. After all, we knew how to make balloon flowers and dogs and swords!!! We got others to help with games and face painting and hotdogs and just loved on the neighborhood kids. The kids had a ball and I am surprised we were able to walk out the double doors we were so proud of the event and the way God had worked that day.

Soon after that we contacted KornPop and he agreed to mentor us and started a new TCA Clown Alley, so we could continue learning how to clown. Our new club (Rosy Nose) needed officers so I stepped up to be secretary for the first three years and during that time we got news that Rosey Nose Clown Alley was going to host the TCA Convention. Now that was a real eye opener and we learned a whole lot more. I loved going to the conventions and learning and then got to see how great it was to be a small part of organizing one for everyone that wanted to learn and have fun.

Plain Jane, Rice Cakes and I decided we wanted to be working for the Lord so we wouldn't be charging for our services and we would be the "SonShine Sisters". (You do know that if you don't charge, you have more business then you can do, don't you)? We have done what we call Kids Zone, which is like an old fashion bible school with just cookies and sandwiches, a bible story, balloons, games and songs at a rec center in the community or

a church. (like three almost every summer at rec centers or at my church). We were asked to go to Corpus Christi to do a weeklong VBS, adding in visiting Driscoll Children's Hospital, and Nursing homes for a friend of mine, and lots of nearby nursing homes and car shows.

At the convention in Houston, I was asked if the Sonshine Sisters would like to go to a prison as a new ministry. WOW, now that was way outside my point of vision. I said I would contact the guy from Lindale and see what all was involved. I have to say, it was a shock when he said, we could talk about Jesus as much as we wanted to as we ministered to the families and inmates at the Texas State Day with Dad program. I talked to the girls and we agreed to try it and have been absolutely hooked on the program and the way God is using us inside the locked doors of 7 units in East Texas.

When clowning, it is very important, I like to touch the hearts of those for whom you are performing. You see I want to be an Ambassador for God's Love. Most people can take themselves less seriously, as they are encouraged to relax and enjoy the moment. The clown can provide the counterweight to whatever is challenging and upsetting in their lives. It is my privilege to be able to provide people with a distraction from the sadness in their lives. To talk to them and show them the way to Jesus or just to pray with them about things that are heavy on their hearts.

Through the years, we have added and taken away from the SonShine Sisters, we now have DeeDee

Kirpatrick and Sharon Boyd in our group.

Sharon joined recently after she had a stroke and couldn't speak. When we went to the hospital to see her, we weren't sure she would make it to her earthly home again, so when she pointed and was impressed with a flower in a clown's hair, she was given that flower and told she would have to work hard and when she got well, she could join us as part of the Sunshine Sisters and all she had to do was give the flower back whenever she was ready. It was perhaps a ten-minute visit that conveyed empathy, a supportive presence, and a break from the loneliness and isolation that she was experiencing. She waved and offered another crooked smile as we left her room. Months later, she came to church and handed the flower to the Sister and she started into her clown training.

It is a real privilege when others allow you to enter their world. Humor is the door through which we can meet people in their time of worry or isolation. Ironically one of the key traits for a clown is that we bring our own inadequacy and humility into our clown character. People may not experience happiness as a result of our spending time with them, but the Spirit of Christ will help them feel less anxious, helpless or isolated. One of the key attitudes for a clown is that we should be ready to play, not to "make" people laugh. Our job is to make a connection with the person. Having fun rather than "being funny." Caring clowns don't have a repertoire of jokes; instead they are the joke, finding a way to

laugh at ourselves and to "bring others along" to have fun with you.

While not everyone will agree that the idea of clowning is a worthwhile way to convey the Christian faith; we should never stop looking for opportunities to share our faith through clowning.

Whatever your goal in clowning is, I want to encourage you to touch the hearts of those in need of a special memory, a shared personal moment or just a sweet smile. Get started by calling a Nursing home and ask if you can come in and share balloons or just spend time with the residents. Make up some balloon flowers and go visit someone in the hospital. Nurses also love balloon flowers or puppy dogs. It makes their day. The art of connecting with those less fortunate than you is a blessing you will receive and not forget. I can't make balloon dogs. Make a dog out of Marti Gras beads. Carry it to a nurse in your pocket. They love them

So, on that, I have to pass this "TAG! You're It!" You're it Aurora Krause "BEBOP".

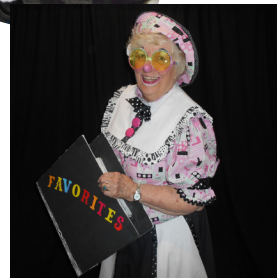
