





It was early in the 80's and I'd only been doing children's birthday parties for a few years. Just before Valentines Day, I decided I'd deliver singing telegrams. My husband thought it was a stupid idea, that no one would want a clown coming into their business. I mentioned it to a friend and she immediately said she wanted me to do a special delivery for her husband. I didn't do any advertising, but each time I did a delivery, I was hired on the spot, to deliver to someone else! I spent the entire day blowing up balloons (for the balloon bo-kay) that was included in each delivery, and driving from one place to another to catch the person off guard.







By the end of the day I had made nearly \$500 (to my husband's surprise.) I had gone to restaurants, schools, banks, the police dept, the library and other fun places. Each time I was hired on the spot to go to another place. I continued to deliver for probably over 30 years. The funny part is, I have never sung a note. No one (not one person) has ever noticed.




Are You Getting Excited?


