# PSYCHIC CARD TRICK



Layout TWELVE cards face up in the following pattern, make certain to put RED and BLACK cards in this exact arrangement (R=red card and B=black card).

B R B

BRR

R R B

R B B

Ask volunteer to select any BLACK card (do not remove it) but not to reveal selection to you.

Then ask them to move UP or DOWN to the nearest RED card.

Then ask them to move LEFT or RIGHT to the nearest BLACK card.

Then ask them to move DIAGONALLY to the nearest RED card.

Then ask them to move UP or DOWN to the nearest BLACK card.

Then tell them that their final card is the BLACK card on the bottom row in the middle.

Works every time. Good luck and have fun!


Registration opens on Friday at 11:30am and opens again on Saturday at 7:30am.

## Clown Shoe Relay Race

#### Supplies needed:

- 6 Clown Shoe soles cut out of  $\frac{1}{4}$ " plywood or equivalent

Paint each pair a different bright color. Glue mesh foam shelf liner to the bottoms of each "sole" to prevent slipping.

Divide children into 3 teams. Divide each team into pairs. (In uneven teams, some kids may have to go twice.) Each pair has both a "put-er downer" and a "stepper on-er." As one child from

each team puts his/her "clown shoe" down, the other child steps on it. They continue this process until they reach the other side. Then they reverse roles. The "put-er downer" becomes the "stepper on-er" and vice versa. And, as usual, the first team to complete the race and all sit down is declared the winner.

## The Mummy Game

#### Supplies needed:

- 1 BIG roll of toilet paper for each team
- trash bag

Divide children into groups so that there is an equal number on each team.

Each team selects a "Mummy." The remaining team members wrap the Mummy from head to toe in toilet paper. The team finishing first is declared the winner.

With an all girl party, each team can wrap 1 girl as a "Princess" or "Bride" complete with veil, train, and bouquet. I usually give the teams a time limit and then judge both teams as winners. Girls can be really creative with this one.

I hope these games work well for you. They're simple, yet entertaining. Moms will love them. They photograph really well.
