Keedo's Prop Shop: Foam Core Signs

Foam Core (FC) makes a great looking, sturdy sign for your skit. You can stick letters to it you have purchased from an office supply or write directly on it with markers or paint. OR make the sign on the computer so pictures can be added. Make and print out the page and have it enlarged at Kinko's to YOUR poster size. Remember: Your poster size is the size of the bottom of the largest suitcase you carry to conventions. (You never know, so plan ahead.) Put newspaper under the edges of the FC to catch the over spray. Center the enlarged paper on the FC. I use 4 straight pins at the corners to hold the paper squarely in place. Take the left or right side loose & spray 3M Super 77 Spray Adhesive (found at craft stores) evenly on that half of your FC. Start smoothing the paper down into the glue from the center out to the



edges. Loose the other edge & repeat the process. To really jazz up your sign you can allow a couple inches around the enlarged picture out to the edge of the FC for attaching a frame. Make 4 strips the length to fit inside the edges of the F C. I use a 2-inch width because that is the width of the straight edge I use. It just makes for easier cutting. Make it from colored FC or decorate white FC to accent your sign. Spray the backs & attach. Or you could cover the strips with contact paper, maybe a cow pattern, if that goes with the theme of the skit. Attach these with low melt hot glue. Because of the edges from the contact paper on the backside of the strips, the surface isn't flat enough to use spray adhesive. The frame could be all one piece. This looks the nicest, but requires a big piece of FC instead of scrap pieces.

I guess at some point it doesn’t really make any difference and you become proud of your age. She was born in Florida. She has never been married. She has a brother and sister that never un-

derstood why she wanted to be a clown, they thought it was silly - she said that is why she is a clown, so she can be silly. They didn’t understand how important it is to make people happy. She has a niece in San Antonio and that is why she moved to a nursing home near her.



She attended several colleges and was proud to graduate. She continued furthering her education by going to various classes while working. She had a long time career in the Foreign Service, working for the US government.

She lived and traveled all over the world - Germany, Switzerland, France, Holland, just to name a few. Traveling was one of her favorite things to do during her lifetime. In her later years of life she discovered the world of clowning. She was at

church with a friend and they saw a clown perform.

They thought it would be so much fun to become a clown. She decided to attend clown school in Houston. Her friend did not become a clown, but would come to watch and encourage her.
