Come Walk With The Doc! Please Join Us Wed. Sept 21st 5:00 p.m.

We have something special planned for opening day of the conference. A "walk with the Doc" Dr. Michael Blanc, Interventional Cardiologist from San Angelo Community Medical Center and Community members will move their weekly walk to meet and greet the clowns at the gazebo across from the Convention Center.

Each week a different topic on health is discussed. The weekly discussion will be on the effects of humor and laughter on our health and well being.

"It was 16 years ago I learned that humor truly is good medicine and why hospitals should include clowns as part of the healing process. Since 2003, I have been a working clown at San Angelo Community Medical Center doing "Clown Rounds" for staff, patients, caregivers and family members. Doctor Blanc is one of my greatest cheer leaders and will share how and why a humorous attitude and laughter is good for your heart and your health." Piccolo"

Keedo's Prop Shop: Color Changing Teapot by Joyce "Keedo" Dowell

Today you'll need: a used or new teapot, one freezie-pop container, a coping saw, Epoxy glue &



Polyurethane (a clear paint). We are going to make a Color Changing Teapot. You can find a teapot at a thrift store & the freezie-pop container at a dollar store. Thoroughly clean the teapot & check for leaks. If it leaks put a layer of Polyurethane covering the bottom of the inside of the teapot. This will seal any leaks. With the coping saw cut the freezie-pop containers apart. Epoxy five of the containers to the bottom of the teapot. Be sure to put all the containers in the center with all the tops touching. When gluing the tops together, do a neat job so silks or crepe paper won't snag as they are pulled out. Allow everything to dry. Fill the kettle several times with water at different levels until you find a level where you can pour water & not flood the containers. Mark this with a Sharpie. If necessary, use a funnel to fill the pot to keep from spilling water on your silks. Now fill up the kettle with water & practice, practice, practice! I use five stem glasses with three drops each of different color food colorings dried overnight in four.


Warm water in the teapot works best in reactivating the food coloring. When you pick up the glasses, hold them so your hand covers the food coloring area so no one sees it. I start with pouring water in the clear glass and take a drink. I continue with my patter and I pull out the green silk. Wrap it around the stem of the glass with the green coloring in it – pour the water and it looks as if you have poured green water out of the same teapot. Continue with blue, red, black, & yellow. I finish by poring water into the clear glass again. Ya'll choose colors for your own patter. Note to Gospel Clowns: I use these colors because the patter is the 23rd Psalm. I shall not want (clear), green pastures (green), still waters (blue), He leadeth me (red), shadow of death (black), anointed my head with oil (yellow), goodness & mercy (clear) This also can be used in a similar manner as the Wordless book is used for the Salvation Message.

TCA Board of Directors Meeting Minutes

Date: April 30, 2016

Meeting was called to order at 10:04 am by Andy Anderson in the Visione Room at the site of the 2017 Convention at La Torretta Resort & Spa, 600 La Torretta Boulevard, Montgomery, TX 77356.

In attendance were the following: Andy Anderson, Christie McNeil, Patsy McMillan, Mauri Norris, Kathy Keaton, Martha Warren, Judy Cornett, Voncille Hardy-Cox, Greg Stanford, and Diana McCurtain-Talbert.

1. Guests were Mary Whipple, Pam Blacklock and Rhea Anderson.

2. Minutes: The minutes from the January board meeting were sent out by Patsy McMillan via email. Mauri Norris motioned to accept minutes and Christie McNeil seconded the motion. All approved unanimously. These will be sent to Greg Stanford to be posted on website and published in the Joey Journal.

3. Treasurer's Report: Mauri Norris distributed the treasurer's report showing us to have \$41,190.66 with only two Joey Journal distributions in these numbers. We have already experienced \$600 for the board expenses out of the \$1500 budgeted. The 990N, E postcard tax return has been filed. Current members through 3/31/16 is 144. We are still lagging behind on dues and it was noted that a lot of people wait until convention to pay dues but then don't receive the Joey Journal to have convention information. It was discovered last year that we weren't covered for conventions in our insurance policy, but it has been corrected this year; and Dwayne Wilhite's early convention registration was donated to the Gideon's, Christie McNeil motioned that we accept the budget as presented and Diana McCurtain-Talbert seconded - passed unanimously. It will be filed for audit.

4. Convention Reports:

2016 Oops Alley Convention Report:

Kathy Keaton says that everything is coming together and they feel pretty organized with everything at this time. Diana McCurtain-Talbert is going to help them with advertising. Also have several sponsors to help with cost. Oops alley is going to do some entertaining to reciprocate for the sponsors. They are coordinating that for possibly the day ahead. Mary said they are trying branch out and do something that hasn't been done in a while. Mary said they are planning to have a king and queen of prom and other fun things that you did in high school. Looks like they are being creative but would like to have ideas from the membership. Martha Warren suggested having a caricature artist.

5. Committee Reports:

Southeast – Judy Cornett did an article for Joey Journal for the Texas clowns that were at COAI. . Mentioned that Cheerful will be starting clown school on June 14th with 8 week class and Lew E Andrews will be the Saturday workshop on July 16th. It is open to all alleys and we will get back to you with the fee. Judy checked with all the alleys in her area and Cheerful was very responsive because they are the only alley that is still active.

Tabling the timeline discussion until the next board meeting. Diana McCurtain-Talbert made a motion to change the split to 60% host/ 40% TCA for the net profit of convention monies starting with the 2017 convention. Christie McNeil seconded. Vote was unanimous.

The Board agreed on TCA putting a full page ad in the 2016 convention book at a cost of \$100 – which will be designed by Diana McCurtain Talbert - all agreed unanimously.

Background checks: This discussion is because of the change in the world today. It is becoming necessary for everyone working with children to have a background check. Will need a security officer to handle paperwork for you to give you a YES or NO only – not any details of the rejection. It was decided to table the background discussion until the next board meeting.
