Airbrush Artist at Convention

For this year's convention, we are excited to announce Ralph Kelly of Airgrafix as one of our many vendors. Ralph Kelly is a self-taught airbrush artist whose work has been showcased in Airbrush Action Magazine multiple times. He first appeared in the reader gallery section of Airbrush Action's November/December issue in 2013. By July of the following year. Kelly had a three page article Featuring him as "The hardest working man in the t-shirt airbrushing game." In that issue, you will see a picture of our very own "Nannah Banana" being airbrushed step by step in caricature form onto a t-shirt. Kelly also made the front cover of Airbrush Action Magazine for their November/December issue in 2014 with his mobile airbrush vehicle.

For the last few years Kelly has been traveling around Houston and Galveston, taking his talents to birthday parties and business events. He does caricatures in black & white, color and digital. He offers airbrushing on the spot for t-shirts and fisherman caps. Kelly also provides airbrush face painting and tattoos.

For the last four years, U-Jean (Rey Canales) has been learning the art of airbrushing and caricatures from Kelly. Just last year Kelly opened his doors for Lulu the Clown to work Halloween weekend at his shop.

For the convention, Kelly will be creating caricatures on paper and t-shirts. He will have white shirts in sizes small to extra-large but you are welcome to bring in your own shirt or accessory (jacket, tote bag, clown props). Dark colored items will cost more to airbrush due to the amount of paint needed. There will be an example banner displayed and Kelly will be taking orders for custom banners if you are interested. The banners will be shipped to you at a later time but the airbrush work will be done on-site. Kelly will also have his instructional DVD's on airbrushing and caricatures available to purchase.




Keedo's Prop Shop: Briefcase



This illusion will amaze your audience! You will need an old briefcase - the cheap card-board type,



duct tape & a regular size basketball. Here is where we see if you read instructions or just look at the diagrams. Cut a 9½-inch circle in the center of the BOTTOM of the briefcase. The picture shows it in the lid. On a flat surface, criss-cross 2 - 17 inch strips of duct tape. Now do it again placing the sticky sides together. This makes the harness for the basketball. Test fit this with the basketball & the briefcase in the closed position. The length of the strips will be slightly different if the thickness of the briefcase is other than 4 inches. Tape the ends down to the inside of the opening in the bottom of the briefcase with more duct tape. Finished! How easy was that? OPTIONAL: If you want to go the extra step & hide everything, you can staple a square of black spandex type material around the edges of the bottom of the briefcase (swimsuit material isle at Hancock's). Test fit the black spandex with the basketball in the harness before you cut it to size. To dress it up even further, you might cover the front with your favorite contact paper and add colored electrical tape around the edges where the contact paper stops. This can make a great entrance for you. As you come in set the case down standing up on the table in front of you. Whether you cover the backside of the briefcase or not, always keep the normal side of the case facing the audience. As you start to lay it down, unlatch the lid, letting it open up as the basketball comes into the inside of the briefcase. Have a friend watch as you practice this move. Then take the ball from the open briefcase and bounce it a couple times. This proves it's real and has a great "WOW" factor!

Clowns Touch the Heart by Shirley "Daisy Dot" Hamilton

When clowning, it is very important to touch the hearts of those for whom you are performing. When I started clowning, I learned the basics for makeup and character development and began going to nursing homes and hospitals. I was an ambassador for God's Love. Most people can take themselves less seriously, as they are encouraged to relax and enjoy the moment. The clown can provide the counterweight to whatever is challenging and upsetting in their lives. It is my privilege to be able to provide people with a distraction from the sadness in their lives.

As a clown, R. Alec Chamberlain once wrote, "I add a tear to my cheek when I put on my make-up. This represents that clowns walk a tightrope between the silly and the tragic." I once visited a stroke patient who had lost the ability to speak. I decided that I also needed to be mute as well. I sat down, looked at the news program on TV and then shrugged my shoulders and added a looping circle with my head to indicate the world is crazy. The patient responded with a lop-sided smile. I then looked intently at her. After a brief period of silence I frowned and pointed to the tear on my face. Her own face crumpled and tears flowed from

her own eyes as she held my hand. I sighed, she sighed. It was perhaps a ten-minute visit that conveyed empathy, a supportive presence, and a break from the loneliness and isolation that she was experiencing. She waved and offered another crooked smile as I left her room.

It is a real privilege when others allow you to enter their world. Humor is the



door through which we can meet people in their time of worry or isolation. Ironically one of the key traits for a clown is that we bring our own inadequacy and humility into our clown character. People may not experience happiness as a result of our spending time with them, but the Spirit of Christ will help them feel less anxious, helpless or isolated. One of the key attitudes for a clown is that we should be ready to play, not to "make" people laugh. Our job is to make a connection with the person. Having fun rather than "being funny." Caring clowns don't have a repertoire of jokes; instead they are the joke, finding a way to laugh at ourselves and to "bring others along" to have fun with you.



While not everyone will agree that the idea of clowning is a worthwhile way to convey the Christian faith; we should never stop looking for opportunities to share our faith through clowning. What kind of clowning is appropriate for a faithbased community? Most of us are familiar with the circus clown that we remember from our childhood. It is my conviction that the circus clown's approach is not necessarily appropriate in church. The circus clown seeks to entertain. The clown that is seeking to convey a theological concept is also wanting to make a connection with the person or people. The circus clown is looking for a laugh or applause, which is a different goal from the caring clown. As a Baptist Disaster Relief Chaplain and a clown, I use humor to find something in common with the other person or group so that a relationship can be established.

Two different types of clowns are associated with faith-based communities (1) Liturgical clowns (2) Caring clowns. Liturgical clowns use choreographed drama and scriptural stories to convey theological concepts. Many are trained in dance, theater or gymnastics. Everything they do from makeup to actions comes from a deep sense of faith. Their ministry is to convey, joy, awe, wonder and the story of Christ. Caring clowns or hospital clowns often visit nursing homes and hospitals to provide humor and

emotional healing for children and adults. Many residents or patients are needing a reason to relieve their discouragement and depression. The Caring clown is there to help lighten their mood or divert and dispel some of the intense situations that these people are experiencing. Caring clowns bring with them the element of surprise, joy and empathy.

Whatever your goal in clowning is, I want to encourage you to touch the hearts of those in need of a special memory, a shared personal moment or just a sweet smile. Get started by calling a nursing home and ask if you can come in and share balloons or just spend time with the residents. Make up some balloon flowers and go visit someone in the hospital. Nurses also love balloon flowers or puppy dogs. It makes their day. The art of connecting with those less fortunate than you is a blessing you will receive and not forget.

You may have already seen an article in this Joey Journal by Rey "U-Jean" Canales about our airbrush artist Ralph Kelly. We are really excited to have an airbrush artist back at TCA after an

absence of many years. Mr. Kelly of Airgrafix will be with us painting caricatures on paper and t-shirts. He will have t-shirts available at his booth up to size XL, but if you need a shirt size larger than XL you should bring your own. If you want your caricature on anything else such as hats, light weight jackets, or tote bags you will need to supply them also. He is able to paint on darker colored items, but they require more paint and time so that will be reflected in a higher price. And for all of you professional clowns he will be taking orders for custom banners, they will be shipped to you after the convention.

Not only do we have Julie "Lovely Buttons" Varholdt and Regina "Cha Cha" Wollrabe coming we have some amazing local Houston talent that you have never seen before or haven't seen at TCA for many years. Some of those names are Clarance "Mr. Sunshine" Bull, Terri "Happy Heart" Stokes and Michael Crayton two amazing balloon artists, also Becky "Skeeter" Deltenere and Mary "Starlight" Morris both of these ladies are fabulous face painters.
