GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING

Date: August 2, 2018

- 1. Meeting was called to order at 3:47pm. Judy Cornett asked the membership to review the previous minutes that were handed out while she goes forward with the other agenda items.

- 4. <u>2018 Convention</u>: Judy Cornett thanked Mid Cities for all their efforts in putting the convention together and asked Susan Keys and Cinde Sanders to come to the front to do a report and announcements.
